Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Ruben Mkoian, Asmik Karapetian, and
Arthur Mkoian.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR RUBEN**
4 **MKOIAN, ASMIK KARAPETIAN, AND ARTHUR**
5 **MKOIAN.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
7 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1151), Ruben Mkoian, Asmik Karapetian,
9 and Arthur Mkoian shall each be eligible for the issuance
10 of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that
11 of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence

1 upon filing an application for issuance of an immigrant
2 visa under section 204 of such Act (8 U.S.C. 1154) or
3 for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resident.

4 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Ruben Mkoian,
5 Asmik Karapetian, or Arthur Mkoian enters the United
6 States before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c),
7 Ruben Mkoian, Asmik Karapetian, or Arthur Mkoian, as
8 appropriate, shall be considered to have entered and re-
9 mained lawfully in the United States and shall be eligible
10 for adjustment of status under section 245 of the Immi-
11 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1255) as of the date
12 of the enactment of this Act.

13 (c) APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF FEES.—Sub-
14 sections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for
15 the issuance of an immigrant visa or the application for
16 adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees not
17 later than two years after the date of the enactment of
18 this Act.

19 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.—
20 Upon granting an immigrant visa or permanent resident
21 status to Ruben Mkoian, Asmik Karapetian, and Arthur
22 Mkoian, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper
23 officer to reduce by three, during the current or next fol-
24 lowing fiscal year—

1 (1) the total number of immigrant visas that
2 are made available to natives of the country of birth
3 of Ruben Mkoian, Asmik Karapetian, and Arthur
4 Mkoian under section 203(a) of the Immigration
5 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)); or

6 (2) if applicable, the total number of immigrant
7 visas that are made available to natives of the coun-
8 try of birth of Ruben Mkoian, Asmik Karapetian,
9 and Arthur Mkoian under section 202(e) of such Act
10 (8 U.S.C. 1152(e)).

11 (e) PAYGO.—The budgetary effects of this Act, for
12 the purpose of complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-
13 Go Act of 2010, shall be determined by reference to the
14 latest statement titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO
15 Legislation” for this Act, submitted for printing in the
16 Congressional Record by the Chairman of the Senate
17 Budget Committee, provided that such statement has been
18 submitted prior to the vote on passage.

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
