Mr. PAUL introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and
referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the disapproval of the proposed export to the
Government of Egypt of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the issuance of a letter of offer with respect to any
4 of the following proposed exports to the Government of
5 Egypt (described in the certification Transmittal No. 18–
6 47, sent to the Speaker of the House of Representatives
7 and the chairman of the Committee on Foreign Relations
8 of the Senate pursuant to section 36(b)(1) of the Arms
9 Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)(1)) on November
10 28, 2018), is hereby prohibited:

1 (1) The proposed sale of 46,000 120MM Target
2 Practice—Tracer (M831A1) and 120MM Target
3 Practice, Cone Stabilized, Discarding Sabot—
4 (M865) rounds (Transmittal Numbered 18–47).

5 (2) The proposed sale of 10,000 120MM 4th-
6 Generation Kinetic Energy-Tungsten (KE-W) A4
7 Armor-Piercing Fin-Stabilized Discarding Sabot
8 with Tracer (APFSDS-T) rounds (Transmittal
9 Numbered 18–47).

10 (3) The proposed sale of 4,500 120MM Insensi-
11 tive Munitions High Explosive with Tracer (IM HE-
12 T) tank rounds, field implementation, testing inspec-
13 tions, spares and repair parts, support and test
14 equipment, field support publications and technical
15 data, U.S. government and contractor engineering
16 and logistics support services, personnel training and
17 training equipment, quality assurance team support
18 services, preparation of ammunition for shipment,
19 ammunition delivery, component improvement pro-
20 gram and repair, other associated equipment and
21 support, and other related elements of logistical and
22 program support (Transmittal Numbered 18–47).

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
