RESOLUTION

Commemorating the 10th anniversary of the tragic events
at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University
on April 16, 2007.

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate—

3 lives as a result of the tragic events at Virginia Poly-
4 technic Institute and State University (referred to as
5 “Virginia Tech”) on April 16, 2007, Ross A.

20 (5) recognizes—

21 (A) the resilience of the Virginia Tech
22 community in the decade following the tragedy
23 of April 16, 2007; and

- 3 munities that experience similar tragedies.
