# S. RES. 337

Designating November 26, 2017, as “Drive Safer Sunday”.

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IN THE SENATE OF THE UNITED STATES

NOVEMBER 16, 2017

Mr. ISAKSON (for himself, Mr. COONS, and Mr. PERDUE) submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

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## RESOLUTION

Designating November 26, 2017, as “Drive Safer Sunday”.

Whereas motor vehicle travel is the primary means of transportation in the United States;

Whereas every individual traveling on roads and highways should drive in a safe manner so as to reduce deaths and injuries that result from motor vehicle accidents;

Whereas, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, wearing a seat belt saves as many as 15,000 lives each year; and

Whereas the Sunday after Thanksgiving is the busiest highway traffic day of the year: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved*, That the Senate—

2               (1) encourages—

1 (A) high schools, colleges, universities, ad-  
2 ministrators, teachers, primary schools, and  
3 secondary schools to launch campus-wide edu-  
4 cational campaigns to urge students to focus on  
5 safety when driving;

6 (B) national trucking firms—

7 (i) to alert employee drivers to be es-  
8 pecially focused on driving safely on the  
9 Sunday after Thanksgiving; and

10 (ii) to publicize the importance of  
11 driving safely on the Sunday after Thanks-  
12 giving on the Citizens Band Radio Service  
13 and at truck stops across the United  
14 States;

15 (C) clergies to remind congregations to  
16 travel safely when attending services and gath-  
17 erings;

18 (D) law enforcement personnel to remind  
19 drivers and passengers to drive safely, particu-  
20 larly on the Sunday after Thanksgiving;

21 (E) motorists to drive safely during the  
22 holiday season and throughout the rest of the  
23 year; and

24 (F) the people of the United States—

- 1 (i) to understand the life-saving im-  
2 portance of wearing a seat belt; and  
3 (ii) to educate themselves about high-  
4 way safety; and  
5 (2) designates November 26, 2017, as “Drive  
6 Safer Sunday”.

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
