Mr. GRAHAM (for himself and Mr. COONS) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Senate that President Donald Trump should hold the Government of the Russian Federation accountable for its interference in the 2016 United States election and ensure that the United States is prepared to counter future attempts at election interference.

Whereas it is the unanimous opinion of the United States intelligence community under both the Administration of President Barack Obama and the Administration of President Donald Trump that the Government of the Russian Federation interfered in the 2016 United States election; and

Whereas it is the unanimous opinion of the intelligence community that the Government of the Russian Federation

will interfere in the 2018 United States election and in future elections of the United States: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the Senate that
2 President Donald Trump—

3 (1) should use every opportunity and every tool
4 at his disposal, including the upcoming summit with
5 the President of the Russian Federation Vladimir
6 Putin, to hold the Government of the Russian Fed-
7 eration accountable for its attempts to undermine
8 democracy in the United States and abroad;

9 (2) should ensure that the United States Gov-
10 ernment is prepared to counter future attempts to
11 interfere in United States elections; and

12 (3) must clarify to President Putin that if the
13 Government of the Russian Federation continues to
14 interfere with democracy in the United States, it
15 does so at its own peril.
