Mr. BYRNE (for himself and Mr. BARR) submitted the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to limit the number of terms a Representative or Senator may serve.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*
3 *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-*
4 *lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-*
5 *stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all*
6 *intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when*
7 *ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several*
8 *States within seven years after the date of its submission*
9 *for ratification:*

1 “ARTICLE —

2 “SECTION 1. No person who has been a Senator for
3 two terms shall again be eligible for election or appoint-
4 ment to the Senate.

5 “SECTION 2. No person who has been a Representa-
6 tive for six terms shall again be eligible for election to the
7 House of Representatives.

8 “SECTION 3. For the purposes of this article, any
9 term that began before the date of the ratification of this
10 article shall not be included in determining the number
11 of terms that a person has been a Senator or Representa-
12 tive.”.
