A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to amend the schedule for rating disabilities to add a diagnostic code and evaluation criteria for obliterative bronchiolitis, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Burn Pit Veterans Re-
5 vision Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REVISION OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS**2 **DISABILITY RATING SCHEDULE WITH RE-**
3 **SPECT TO OBLITERATIVE BRONCHIOLITIS.**4 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall—6 (1) amend the schedule for rating disabilities
7 pursuant to section 1155 of title 38, United States
8 Code, to add a diagnostic code and evaluation cri-
9 teria for obliterative bronchiolitis; and10 (2) provide a process by which a veteran who,
11 as of the date of the enactment of this Act, is receiv-
12 ing compensation under chapter 11 of such title for
13 a service-connected disability—14 (A) may have such service-connected dis-
15 ability reevaluated based on the diagnostic code
16 and evaluation criteria described in paragraph
17 (1); and18 (B) may be assigned a new disability rat-
19 ing as a result of such reevaluation, if such as-
20 signment does not reduce the disability rating
21 of such veteran in effect immediately prior to
22 the date of such assignment.
