- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Keep Congress Work-
- 5 ing Act".

1 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ADJOURNMENT.

- 2 Section 309 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974
- 3 is amended by inserting "(a) JULY RECESS.—" and by
- 4 adding at the end the following new subsection:
- 5 "(b) Motion To Adjourn During Lapses in Ap-
- 6 PROPRIATIONS.—It shall not be in order in the House of
- 7 Representatives or the Senate to adjourn for a period of
- 8 more than 12 hours during any lapse in appropriations
- 9 for all or part of the Government.".

- 13 ing "309(b)," after "306,".
