A BILL

To amend the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to prohibit an adjournment for a period of more than 12 hours in the event of a lapse in appropriations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keep Congress Work-
5 ing Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ADJOURNMENT.**

2 Section 309 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974
3 is amended by inserting “(a) JULY RECESS.—” and by
4 adding at the end the following new subsection:

5 “(b) MOTION TO ADJOURN DURING LAPSES IN AP-
6 PROPRIATIONS.—It shall not be in order in the House of
7 Representatives or the Senate to adjourn for a period of
8 more than 12 hours during any lapse in appropriations
9 for all or part of the Government.”.

10 **SEC. 3. WAIVERS AND APPEALS.**

11 Subsections (c)(1) and (d)(2) of section 904 of the
12 Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are amended by insert-
13 ing “309(b),” after “306,”.
