## A BILL

To require any delivery vehicle owned or leased by the United States Postal Service have an air conditioning unit, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Peggy Frank Memorial  
5       Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. REQUIRING POSTAL SERVICE DELIVERY VEHICLES**

7                       **TO HAVE AIR CONDITIONING UNITS.**

8       (a) CURRENT VEHICLES.—

9               (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 3 years after  
10       the date of enactment of this Act, any delivery vehi-

1       cle owned or leased by the United States Postal  
2       Service as of that date shall be modified to include  
3       an air conditioning unit.

4               (2) ANNUAL REPORT.—The Postmaster General  
5       shall submit a progress report to Congress not later  
6       than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act  
7       and annually thereafter until the modifications re-  
8       quired under this subsection are complete.

9               (b) FUTURE VEHICLES.—On or after the date of en-  
10      actment of this Act, the Postmaster General may not pur-  
11      chase or lease any delivery vehicle for use by the United  
12      States Postal Service unless that vehicle has an air condi-  
13      tioning unit.
