A BILL

To require any delivery vehicle owned or leased by the United States Postal Service have an air conditioning unit, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Peggy Frank Memorial
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REQUIRING POSTAL SERVICE DELIVERY VEHICLES
- 7 TO HAVE AIR CONDITIONING UNITS.
- 8 (a) Current Vehicles.—
- 9 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 3 years after
- the date of enactment of this Act, any delivery vehi-

- 1 cle owned or leased by the United States Postal 2 Service as of that date shall be modified to include 3 an air conditioning unit.
- 4 (2) Annual report.—The Postmaster General 5 shall submit a progress report to Congress not later 6 than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act 7 and annually thereafter until the modifications re-8 quired under this subsection are complete.
- 9 (b) FUTURE VEHICLES.—On or after the date of en10 actment of this Act, the Postmaster General may not pur11 chase or lease any delivery vehicle for use by the United
 12 States Postal Service unless that vehicle has an air condi13 tioning unit.
