A BILL

To provide full-year appropriations for the Indian Health Service in the event of a partial lapse in appropriations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pay our Doctors Act
5 of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. FULL-YEAR APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INDIAN**
7 **HEALTH SERVICE.**

8 If a joint resolution making continuing appropria-
9 tions for fiscal year 2019 is not in effect, there is hereby

1 appropriated for fiscal year 2019, out of any money in
2 the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, such sums as
3 may be necessary, at an annualized rate for operations as
4 provided in the Department of the Interior, Environment,
5 and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2018 (division
6 G of Public Law 115–141) for fiscal year 2018 and under
7 the authority and conditions provided in such Act, for con-
8 tinuing projects or activities (including the costs of direct
9 loans and loan guarantees) that were conducted in fiscal
10 year 2018 and for which appropriations, funds, or other
11 authority were made available under any account relating
12 to the Indian Health Service, including the “Indian Health
13 Services”, “Contract Support Costs”, and “Indian Health
14 Facilities” accounts.

15 **SEC. 3. TERMINATION.**

16 Appropriations and funds made available and author-
17 ity granted pursuant to section 2 shall be available until
18 September 30, 2019.

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
