A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make permanent the Indian employment credit.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INDIAN EMPLOYMENT CREDIT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 45A the Internal Revenue
5 Code of 1986 is amended by striking subsection (f).

6 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 45A(e)(1)
7 of such Code is amended by inserting “(determined with-
8 out regard to subsection (c)(4) thereof)” after “section
9 51”.

1 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
3 December 31, 2017.

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
