3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Motorsports Fairness
5 and Permanency Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. 7-YEAR RECOVERY PERIOD FOR MOTORSPORTS EN-**
2 **TERTAINMENT COMPLEXES MADE PERMA-**
3 **NENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 168(i)(15) of the Internal
5 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking subpara-
6 graph (D).

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
8 this section shall apply to property placed in service after
9 December 31, 2017.
