A BILL

To amend the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 to allow the District of Columbia to receive Federal funding under such Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “District of Columbia
5 Flood Prevention Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY OF DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA FOR FED-**
7 **ERAL FUNDING UNDER THE COASTAL ZONE**
8 **MANAGEMENT ACT OF 1972.**

9 Section 304(4) of the Coastal Zone Management Act
10 of 1972 (16 U.S.C. 1453(4)) is amended by inserting “the
11 District of Columbia,” after “the term also includes”.

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
