To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make the work opportunity credit permanent.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WORK OPPORTUNITY CREDIT MADE PERMA-**
4 **NENT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 51(c) of the Internal Rev-
6 enue Code of 1986 is amended by striking paragraph (4)
7 and by redesignating paragraph (5) as paragraph (4).

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 this section shall apply to individuals who begin work for
3 the employer after December 31, 2019.

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
