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1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATING TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT SERV-**
2 **ICES AS EXCEPTED SERVICES UNDER THE**
3 **ANTI-DEFICIENCY ACT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1342 of title 31, United
5 States Code, is amended—

6 (1) by striking “An officer” and inserting “(1)
7 An officer”; and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(2) Any services by an officer or employee relating
10 to paying or reimbursing Federal employees for official
11 travel expenses shall be deemed, for purposes of paragraph
12 (1), services for emergencies involving the safety of human
13 life or the protection of property.”.

14 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendments made by sub-
15 section (a) shall apply to any lapse in appropriations be-
16 ginning on or after October 1, 2020.

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
