- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Corporal Ronil Singh
- 5 and Fallen Heroes Scholarship Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. CALCULATION OF ELIGIBILITY.
- 7 Section 473(b)(2) of the Higher Education Act of
- 8 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1087mm(b)(2)) is amended—

1	(1) in subparagraph (B), by inserting ", or
2	spouse" after "guardian"; and
3	(2) in subparagraph (C), by insert ", or
4	spouse's" after "guardian's".
5	SEC. 3. CALCULATION OF PELL GRANT AMOUNT.
6	Section 401(b)(2) of the Higher Education Act of
7	1965 (20 U.S.C. 1070a(b)(2)) is amended—
8	(1) by striking the matter preceding clause (i)
9	of subparagraph (A) and inserting the following:
10	"(2)(A) Subject to subparagraph (C), the
11	amount of the Federal Pell Grant for a student eligi-
12	ble under this part shall be—"; and
13	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
14	paragraph:
15	"(C) In the case of a student who meets the re-
16	quirements of subparagraphs (A), (B)(ii), and (C) of
17	section 473(b)(2)—
18	"(i) clause (ii) of subparagraph (A) of this
19	paragraph shall be applied by substituting
20	'from the amounts appropriated in the last en-
21	acted appropriation Act applicable to that
22	award year, an amount equal to the amount of
23	the increase calculated under paragraph (7)(B)
24	for that year' for 'the amount of the increase

3	"(ii) such student—
4	"(I) shall be provided an amount
5	under clause (i) of this subparagraph only
6	to the extent that funds are specifically
7	provided in advance in an appropriation

10	"(II) shall not be eligible for the
11	amounts made available pursuant to
12	clauses (i) through (iii) of paragraph
13	(7)(A).".
14	SEC. 4. BUDGETARY EFFECTS.
15	The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
16	complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
17	shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
18	titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this
19	Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
20	by the Chairman of the Budget Committee of the House

21 of Representatives, provided that such statement has been

22 submitted prior to the vote on passage.

1 SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.
