A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services to revise regulations with respect to payment rates for durable medical equipment under the Medicare program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Home Oxy-
- 5 gen and Medical Equipment Act of 2019" or the "Pro-
- 6 tecting HOME Act of 2019".

SEC. 2. REVISING PAYMENT RATES FOR DURABLE MEDICAL

- 4 (a) Rural and Noncontiguous Areas.—Not later
- 5 than December 31, 2020, the Secretary of Health and
- 6 Human Services shall revise section 414.210(g)(9)(iii) of

- 8 regulation), to apply the transition rule described in such
- 9 section to all applicable items and services furnished in
- 10 rural areas and noncontiguous areas (as such terms are
- 11 defined for purposes of such section) on or after June 1,
- 12 2018.
- 13 (b) Areas Other Than Rural and Noncontig-
- 14 Uous Areas.—With respect to items and services fur-
- 15 nished on or after the date that is 30 days after the date
- 16 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and
- 17 Human Services shall apply section 414.210(g)(9)(iv) of
- 18 title 42, Code of Federal Regulations (or any successor
- 19 regulation), as if the reference to "100 percent of the ad-
- 20 justed payment amount established under this section"
- 21 were instead a reference to "75 percent of the adjusted
- 22 payment amount established under this section and 25
- 23 percent of the unadjusted fee schedule amount".

- 7 ary 1, 2020.".
