A BILL

To repeal the provision of law that provides automatic pay
adjustments for Members of Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Raise for Congress
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF AUTOMATIC PAY ADJUSTMENTS**
2 **FOR MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (2) of section 601(a)
4 of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C.
5 4501) is repealed.

6 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—
7 Section 601(a)(1) of such Act (2 U.S.C. 4501(1)) is
8 amended—

9 (1) by striking “(a)(1)” and inserting “(a)”;

10 (2) by redesignating subparagraphs (A), (B),
11 and (C) as paragraphs (1), (2), and (3), respectively;
12 and

13 (3) by striking “as adjusted by paragraph (2)”
14 and inserting “adjusted as provided by law”.

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
