## A BILL

To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to provide that over-the-road bus drivers are covered under the maximum hours requirements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Driver Fatigue Preven-  
5 tion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE FAIR LABOR STANDARDS ACT**  
7 **OF 1938.**

8 Section 13(b)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of  
9 1938 (29 U.S.C. 213(b)(1)) is amended by inserting be-

1 fore the semicolon the following: “, except an employee  
2 employed as a driver of an over-the-road bus, which is a  
3 bus characterized by an elevated passenger deck located  
4 over a baggage compartment.”.
