A BILL

To facilitate the use of certain land in Nebraska for public outdoor recreational opportunities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF CONVEYED LAND.**

4 *Section 342(c) of the Consolidated Natural Resources*
5 *Act of 2008 is amended—*

6 *(1) by striking “The conveyance” and inserting*
7 *the following:*

8 *“(1) PRIMARY USE.—The conveyance”; and*

9 *(2) by adding at the end the following:*

10 *“(2) ADDITIONAL USE.—The Missouri River*
11 *Basin Lewis and Clark Interpretive Trail and Visitor*
12 *Center Foundation, Inc. may use, or enter into an*
13 *agreement with another party to lease, not more than*
14 *40 acres of the land conveyed under subsection (a) for*
15 *public outdoor recreation under the following condi-*
16 *tions:*

17 *“(A) The land shall continue to be main-*
18 *tained in a manner that is compatible with the*
19 *use authorized in paragraph (1), conditions stat-*
20 *ed in the deed for the land, and the memo-*
21 *randum of understanding with the National*
22 *Park Service dated June 2009.*

23 *“(B) The nature trail around the perimeter*
24 *of the land shall remain in place and may be en-*
25 *hanced with educational signage about the flora*

1 *and fauna that are native to the land and plant-*
2 *ing of native flora.*

3 “(C) *Revenue from any use (including any*
4 *lease or agreement entered into) under this para-*
5 *graph shall be used to offset maintenance and*
6 *operating costs of the Lewis and Clark Interpre-*
7 *tive Center.”.*
