## A BILL

To address food and housing insecurity on college campuses.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Closing the College
- 5 Hunger Gap Act of 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. QUESTIONS ON FOOD AND HOUSING INSECURITY IN
- 7 NATIONAL POSTSECONDARY STUDENT AID
- 8 STUDY.
- 9 The Secretary of Education shall add questions that
- 10 measure rates of food and housing insecurity to the Na-
- 11 tional Postsecondary Student Aid Study.

## SEC. 3. INFORMATION ON SNAP ELIGIBILITY.

- 2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 483 of the Higher Edu-
- 3 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1090) is amended by add-
- 4 ing at the end the following:
- 5 "(i) Information on SNAP Eligibility.—
- 6 "(1) IN GENERAL.—For each year for which a 7 student described in paragraph (2) submits a form 8 described in subsection (a), the Secretary shall send 9 to such student information regarding potential eli-10 gibility for assistance under, and application process 11 for, the supplemental nutrition assistance program 12 established under the Food and Nutrition Act of
- 13 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.) in written and elec-
- tronic form. Both the written and electronic commu-
- 15 nication shall include contact information for the
- 16 State agency responsible for administering the sup-
- plemental nutrition assistance program in the State
- in which the student resides.
- 19 "(2) STUDENTS.—A student is described in this
- 20 paragraph if the student has an expected family con-
- 21 tribution equal to zero for the year.".
- (b) Consultation.—The Secretary of Education
- 23 shall consult with the Secretary of Agriculture, and the
- 24 head of any other applicable Federal or State agency, in
- 25 designing the written and electronic communication re-
- 26 garding potential eligibility for assistance under, and ap-

- 1 plication process for, the supplemental nutrition assistance
- 2 program established under the Food and Nutrition Act of
- 3 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.) as described in section
- 4 483(i) of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
- 5 1090(i)).
- 6 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 7 This Act and the amendment made by this Act shall
- 8 take effect 120 days after the date of enactment of this
- 9 Act.
