7 (1) such sums as are necessary to provide pay
8 and allowances to members of the Coast Guard (as
9 described in section 1 of title 14, United States
10 Code), including the reserve component thereof, who
11 perform active service or inactive-duty training dur12 ing such period;

13 (2) such sums as are necessary to provide pay
14 and allowances to civilian employees of the Coast
15 Guard;

16 (3) such sums as are necessary to provide pay17 and allowances to contractors of the Coast Guard;

18 (4) such sums as are necessary for—

19 (A) the payment of a death gratuity under
20 sections 1475 through 1477 and 1489 of title
21 10, United States Code, with respect to mem22 bers of the Coast Guard;

(B) the payment or reimbursement of authorized funeral travel and travel related to the
dignified transfer of remains and unit memorial
services under section 481f of title 37, United
