A BILL

To direct the Attorney General to submit to Congress a report on domestic terrorism, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Domestic Terrorism
5 Information Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON DOMESTIC TERRORISM.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
8 date of the enactment of this Act, the Attorney General
9 shall submit to Congress a report that includes, for the

1 period beginning on January 1, 2009, and ending on the
2 date of the enactment of this Act, the following:

3 (1) The number of individuals arrested by a
4 Federal law enforcement officer pursuant to an in-
5 vestigation of an act of domestic terrorism, the re-
6 sults of each such investigation, and any charges
7 filed pursuant to each such investigation.

8 (2) The number of individuals who have been
9 killed by acts of domestic terrorism.

10 (3) The methods and strategies that the De-
11 partment of Justice uses to prevent domestic ter-
12 rorism.

13 (b) DEFINITION.—In this Act, the term “domestic ter-
14 rorism” has the meaning given that term in section 2331
15 of title 18, United States Code.

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
