A BILL

To prohibit the creation of manufactured emergencies in order to build border walls.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Walls Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. NO NATIONAL EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS FOR**
6 **BORDER WALLS DURING SHUTDOWNS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—No funds made available by any
8 act of law may be used to declare a national emergency
9 with respect to immigration concerns at America’s south-
10 ern border with Mexico or to erect any new border bar-

riers, including fencing or walls, pursuant to a declaration
of a national emergency.

(b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall be enforced during periods in which any Federal agency experiences a lapse in appropriations.

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
