A BILL

To amend the America COMPETES Act to strengthen reporting requirements relating to deficiencies in Federal research infrastructure, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Labs Mod-
5 ernization Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO FED-**
7 **ERAL RESEARCH INFRASTRUCTURE.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1007(c)(1) of the America
9 COMPETES Act (42 U.S.C. 6619(c)(1)) is amended by

1 inserting “and funding for research infrastructure” after
2 “research infrastructure”.

3 (b) GAO REPORT.—Not later than 180 days and
4 every 2 years thereafter, the Comptroller General shall
5 submit to Congress a report that includes—

6 (1) an assessment of the current state of Fed-
7 eral science facilities and related infrastructure, in-
8 cluding with respect to climate control systems, the
9 functionality of equipment and the usage of such
10 equipment, the quality of buildings in which such fa-
11 cilities are housed (including the resiliency of such
12 buildings to changes in climate, weather, and nat-
13 ural surroundings), and the safety of the materials
14 used in construction of facilities;

15 (2) an identification of the facilities in most
16 critical need of repair or renovation;

17 (3) the estimated costs of completing such re-
18 pairs or renovations; and

19 (4) an evaluation of whether facility occupancy
20 is sufficient to meet agency demands.

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
