A BILL

To amend the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956 to exempt the reimbursement for certain travel to return to the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION OF REIMBURSEMENT FOR CER-**
4 **TAIN TRAVEL TO RETURN TO THE UNITED**
5 **STATES.**

6 Section 4 of the State Department Basic Authorities
7 Act of 1956 (22 U.S.C. 2671) is amended by adding at
8 the end the following new subsection:

1 “(e) In the case of a communicable disease for which
2 the Federal Government has issued a travel alert or travel
3 warning, the reimbursement requirements under sub-
4 sections (b)(2)(A)(ii) and (d) shall not apply.”.

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
