A BILL

To amend the Oil Region National Heritage Area Act to reauthorize the Oil Region National Heritage Area, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the “Oil Region National
5 Heritage Area Reauthorization Act”.

6 SEC. 2. OIL REGION NATIONAL HERITAGE AREA ACT.

7 (a) MANAGEMENT ENTITY.—The Oil Region Na-
8 tional Heritage Area Act (Public Law 108–447; 118 Stat.
9 3368) is amended by striking “Oil Heritage Region, Inc.”

1 each place it appears and inserting “Oil Region Alliance
2 of Business, Industry and Tourism”.

3 (b) SUNSET.—Section 608 of the Oil Region National
4 Heritage Area Act (Public Law 108–447; 118 Stat. 3372)
5 is amended to read as follows:

6 **“SEC. 608. SUNSET.”**

7 “The authority of the Secretary to grant or provide
8 any assistance under this title shall terminate on Sep-
9 tember 30, 2026.”.

10 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
11 612(a)(2) of the Oil Region National Heritage Area Act
12 (Public Law 108–447; 118 Stat. 3373) is amended by
13 striking “\$10,000,000” and inserting “\$20,000,000”.
