A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to require States to provide coverage under the Medicaid program for certain individuals during national emergencies, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Emergency Medicaid
5 for Coronavirus Treatment Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR STATES TO PROVIDE MEDICAID**
2 **COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS DUR-**
3 **ING NATIONAL EMERGENCIES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1902 of the Social Secu-
5 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a)(10)(A)(i)—

7 (A) in subclause (VIII), by striking “or” at
8 the end;

9 (B) in subclause (IX), by adding “or” at
10 the end; and

11 (C) by inserting after subclause (IX) the
12 following new subclause:

13 “(X) during any period in which
14 there exists an emergency declared by
15 the President pursuant to the Na-
16 tional Emergencies Act or the Robert
17 T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emer-
18 gency Assistance Act with respect to a
19 disease, who are diagnosed with such
20 disease;”; and

21 (2) in subsection (e), by adding at the end the
22 following new paragraph:

23 “(16) CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY FOR MED-
24 ICAL ASSISTANCE FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS
25 AFTER NATIONAL EMERGENCIES.—In the case
26 of an individual who enrolls under the State

1 plan (or a waiver of such plan) pursuant to
2 subsection (a)(10)(A)(i)(X) during a period de-
3 scribed in such subsection with respect to a dis-
4 ease, such individual shall continue to be eligi-
5 ble under the State plan (or waiver) after the
6 end of such period for any medical assistance
7 available under the State plan (or waiver) re-
8 lated to treatment, including testing services,
9 for such disease.”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This Act and the amend-
11 ments made by this Act shall take effect as if enacted on
12 March 13, 2020.
