Mr. CARTWRIGHT (for himself and Mr. RODNEY DAVIS of Illinois) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To amend the Professional Boxing Safety Act of 1996 to provide additional safety standards for professional boxing.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Professional Boxing
5 Safety Enhancement Act of 2020”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL SAFETY STANDARDS.**

7 Section 5 of the Professional Boxing Safety Act of
8 1996 (15 U.S.C. 6304) is amended—

1 (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by
2 striking “or an alternative requirement in effect
3 under regulations of a boxing commission that pro-
4 vides equivalent protection of the health and safety
5 of boxers”;

6 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (3) and (4) as
7 paragraphs (5) and (6), respectively; and

8 (3) by striking paragraph (2) and inserting the
9 following:

10 “(2) A boxer shall provide with the application
11 for a license or for renewal of the license an original
12 or certified copy of the results of medical tests
13 which—

14 “(A) were performed by a laboratory dur-
15 ing the calendar year for which the license is
16 being issued or no earlier than 30 days before
17 the date on which the application is submitted;

18 “(B) show that the boxer is not infected
19 with the human immunodeficiency virus; and

20 “(C) show that the boxer is not infected
21 with the hepatitis virus.

22 “(3) An ambulance continuously present on
23 site.

1 “(4) Emergency medical personnel with appro-
2 pate resuscitation equipment continuously present
3 on site.”.

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
