A BILL

To provide for the transfer of the TARAWA class amphibious ship USS NASSAU (LHA-4) to Japan.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "FriendSHIP Act".
- 5 SEC. 2. TRANSFER OF THE TARAWA CLASS AMPHIBIOUS
- 6 SHIP USS NASSAU (LHA-4) TO JAPAN.
- 7 (a) Transfer by Sale or Grant.—The President
- 8 is authorized to transfer the TARAWA class amphibious
- 9 ship USS NASSAU (LHA-4) to Japan on a sale basis
- 10 under section 21 of the Arms Export Control Act (22

- 1 U.S.C. 2761) or on a grant basis under section 516 of
- 2 the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2321j).
- 3 (b) Costs of Transfers.—Any expense incurred by
- 4 the United States in connection with a transfer authorized
- 5 by this section shall be charged to the recipient notwith-
- 6 standing section 516(e) of the Foreign Assistance Act of
- 7 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2321j(e)).
- 8 (c) Repair and Refurbishment in United
- 9 States Shipyards.—To the maximum extent prac-
- 10 ticable, the President shall require, as a condition of the
- 11 transfer of a vessel under this section, that the recipient
- 12 to which the vessel is transferred have such repair or re-
- 13 furbishment of the vessel as is needed, before the vessel
- 14 joins the naval forces of that recipient, performed at a
- 15 shipyard located in the United States, including a United
- 16 States Navy shipyard.
- 17 (d) Expiration of Authority.—The authority to
- 18 transfer a vessel under this section shall expire at the end
- 19 of the 3-year period beginning on the date of the enact-
- 20 ment of this Act.

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
