A BILL

To amend the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020 to direct the Secretary of Defense to include questions regarding racism, anti-Semitism, and supremacism in workplace surveys administered by the Secretary.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Department of Defense
5 Anti-Semitism and Racism Awareness Act of 2020”.

1 **SEC. 2. QUESTIONS REGARDING RACISM, ANTI-SEMITISM,**
2 **AND SUPREMACISM IN WORKPLACE SURVEYS**
3 **ADMINISTERED BY THE SECRETARY OF DE-**
4 **FENSE.**

5 Section 593 of the National Defense Authorization
6 Act for Fiscal Year 2020 (Public Law 116–92) is amend-
7 ed—

8 (1) by inserting “(a) QUESTIONS REQUIRED.—
9 ” before “The Secretary”;

10 (2) in paragraph (1), by inserting “, racist,
11 anti-Semitic, or supremacist” after “extremist”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
13 section:

14 “(b) REPORT.—Not later than March 1, 2021, the
15 Secretary shall submit to Congress a report including—

16 “(1) the text of the questions included in sur-
17 veys under subsection (a); and

18 “(2) which surveys include such questions.”.

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
