5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, during 6 fiscal year 2019, with respect to any lapse in appropria-7 tions beginning on or after December 22, 2018, any Fed-8 eral employee who is excepted from furlough and is not 9 being paid due to a lapse in appropriations shall be deemed to be separated from Federal service and eligible
for unemployment compensation benefits under sub chapter I of chapter 85 of title 5, United States Code,
with no waiting period for such eligibility to accrue.
