A BILL

To extend by one year the legislative authority under section 8903(e) of title 40, United States Code, for certain commemorative works.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMMEMORATIVE WORKS LEGISLATIVE AU-**
4 **THORITY EXTENDED.**

5 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
6 “COVID–19 Veterans Memorial Extension Act”.

7 (b) FINDINGS.—Congress finds as follows:

8 (1) America’s veterans served nobly around the
9 world.

1 (2) Veteran memorials face significant chal-
2 lenges to meet fundraising requirements.

3 (3) COVID–19 has disrupted charitable dona-
4 tions significantly.

5 (4) In-progress monuments to honor American
6 leadership at home and abroad should receive flexi-
7 bility to meet the challenges of COVID–19.

8 (c) AUTHORITY.—The seven-year legislative author-
9 ity under section 8903(e) of title 40, United States Code,
10 is hereby extended for a period of one year for each com-
11 memorative work that was authorized under chapter 89
12 of that title during the seven-year period immediately be-
13 fore the date of the enactment of this section.

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
