Mr. ALLEN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To require elementary schools and secondary schools to provide an option for safe, in-person attendance during school year 2020–2021.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Educational Flexibility
5 for Families Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR SAFE, IN-PERSON ATTENDANCE**
7 **OPTION.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on the date of enact-
9 ment of this Act, no amounts are authorized to be appro-
10 priated for school year 2020–2021 to any elementary

1 school or secondary school, or any local educational agency
2 or State educational agency that serves an elementary
3 school or secondary school, that does not provide an option
4 for students to attend classes, safely and in-person, at the
5 school during such school year.

6 (b) DEFINITIONS.—The terms “elementary school”,
7 “secondary school”, “local educational agency”, and
8 “State educational agency” have the meanings given the
9 terms in section 8101 of the Elementary and Secondary
10 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).
