Mr. KEATING introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Oversight and Reform

A BILL

To amend the Inspector General Act of 1978 to prohibit
an acting Inspector General from serving in more than
one position in the Federal Government.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Demanding Uncondi-
5 tional Accountability under the Law for Inspectors Gen-
6 eral Act” or the “DUAL IG Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DUAL ROLE FOR ACTING INSPEC-**
8 **TORS GENERAL.**

9 The Inspector General Act of 1978 (5 U.S.C. App.)
10 is amended in section 3 by adding at the end the following:

1 “(h) In the event of a vacancy in the position of any
2 Inspector General appointed by the President, by and with
3 the advice and consent of the Senate, an acting Inspector
4 General performing the functions and duties of such va-
5 cant position may not perform the functions and duties
6 of any other position within the Government.”.

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
