A BILL

To amend the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 to permit the use of benefits to purchase diapering supplies for small children.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “SNAP for Infant Care
5 Act of 2020”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7 Section 3 of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7
8 U.S.C. 2012) is amended—

1 (1) by inserting after subsection (g) the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(g–1) DIAPERING SUPPLIES.—The term ‘diapering
4 supplies’ includes diapers, diaper wipes, diaper cream, and
5 related items necessary for safe diapering.”, and

6 (2) in subsection (k) by inserting “diapering
7 supplies for a child not more than 3 years of age,”
8 after “of this subsection,”.

9 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

10 This Act, and the amendments made by this Act,
11 shall take effect on the 1st day of the 1st month that be-
12 gins not less than 180 days after the date of the enact-
13 ment of this Act.

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
