A BILL

To amend the Overtime Pay for Protective Services Act of 2016 to extend the Secret Service overtime pay exception through 2025, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Secret Service Over-
5 time Pay Extension Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF OVERTIME PAY EXCEPTION**
2 **THROUGH 2020 FOR PROTECTIVE SERVICES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2 of the Overtime Pay for
4 Protective Services Act of 2016 (5 U.S.C. 5547 note) is
5 amended—

6 (1) in the section heading, by striking “2020”
7 and inserting “2025”;

8 (2) in subsection (a), by striking “or 2020” and
9 inserting “2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, or 2025”;
10 and

11 (3) in subsection (b)(1), by striking “and
12 2020” and inserting “2020, 2021, 2022, 2023,
13 2024, and 2025”.

14 (b) REPORT ON EXTENSIONS.—Not later than Janu-
15 ary 30 of each of calendar years 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025,
16 and 2026, the Director of the Secret Service shall submit
17 to the Committees on Appropriations of the House of Rep-
18 resentatives and the Senate, the Committee on Homeland
19 Security and the Committee on Oversight and Reform of
20 the House of Representatives, and the Committee on
21 Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the Sen-
22 ate a report on the effects of the amendments made by
23 subsection (a). The report shall include, with respect to
24 the previous calendar year, the information described
25 under paragraphs (1) through (7) of section 2(c) of Public
26 Law 115–160.

1 (c) REPEAL OF SUPERSEDED REPORTING REQUIRE-
2 MENT.—Section 2(b) of the Secret Service Overtime Pay
3 Extension Act (Public Law 115–383; 132 Stat. 5121) is
4 repealed.

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
