6 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
7 Postal Service located at 201 West Cherokee Street in

1 Brookhaven, Mississippi, shall be known and designated
2 as the “Deputy Donald William Durr, Corporal Zach
3 Moak, and Patrolman James White Memorial Post Office
4 Building”.

5 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
6 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
7 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
8 be deemed to be a reference to the “Deputy Donald Wil-
9 liam Durr, Corporal Zach Moak, and Patrolman James
10 White Memorial Post Office Building”.

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
