A BILL

To require the Principal Cyber Advisor of the Department of Defense to conduct a study to determine the optimal strategy for structuring and manning elements of the Joint Force Headquarters—Cyber organizations, Joint Mission Operations Centers, and Cyber Operations—Integrated Planning Elements, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defense Cybersecurity
5 Personnel Authorizations and Inventory Oversight Act of
6 2019”.

1 SEC. 2. STUDY TO DETERMINE THE OPTIMAL STRATEGY

2 FOR STRUCTURING AND MANNING ELEMENTS OF THE JOINT FORCE HEAD-
3 QUARTERS-CYBER ORGANIZATIONS, JOINT MISSION OPERATIONS CENTERS, AND CYBER OPERATIONS-INTEGRATED PLANNING ELEMENTS.

7 (a) STUDY.—

8
9 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Principal Cyber Advisor
10 of the Department of Defense shall conduct a study
11 to determine the optimal strategy for structuring
12 and manning elements of the following:

13 (A) Joint Force Headquarters—Cyber organizations.

15 (B) Joint Mission Operations Centers.

16 (C) Cyber Operations—Integrated Planning
17 Elements.

18 (2) ELEMENTS.—The study conducted under
19 subsection (a) shall include assessment of the following:

21 (A) Operational effects on the military
22 services if the entities listed in subparagraphs
23 (A) through (C) of paragraph (1) are restructured
24 from organizations that are service component
25 organizations to joint organizations.

7 (b) REPORT.—

15 (2) CONTENTS.—The report submitted under
16 paragraph (1) shall contain the following:

17 (A) The findings of the Principal Cyber
18 Advisor with respect to the study conducted
19 under subsection (a).

20 (B) Details of the operational and organi-
21 zational effects assessed under subsection
22 (a)(2).

23 (C) A plan to carry out the transfer de-
24 scribed in subsection (a)(2)(B) and the associ-
25 ated costs.
