A BILL

To prohibit the manufacture for sale, offer for sale, distribution in commerce, or importation into the United States of any crib bumper, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Safe Cribs Act of
- 5 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON SALE OF CRIB BUMPERS.
- 7 (a) Prohibition on the Sale of Crib Bump-
- 8 ERS.—Beginning on the date that is 180 days after the

- 1 date of enactment of this Act, it shall be unlawful for any
- 2 person to manufacture for sale, offer for sale, distribute
- 3 in commerce, or import into the United States any crib
- 4 bumper.
- 5 (b) Treatment of Violation.—A violation of sub-
- 6 section (a) shall be treated as a violation of section
- 7 19(a)(1) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C.
- 8 2068(a)(1)).
- 9 (c) Crib Bumper Defined.—In this section, the
- 10 term "crib bumper"—
- 11 (1) means any material that is intended to
- cover the sides of a crib to prevent injury to any crib
- occupant from impacts against the side of a crib or
- to prevent partial or complete access to any openings
- in the sides of a crib to prevent a crib occupant from
- getting any part of the body entrapped in any open-
- ing; and
- 18 (2) includes a padded crib bumper, a supported
- and unsupported vinyl bumper guard, a mesh crib
- liner, and vertical crib slat covers.
