A BILL

To provide for the treatment of a pharmacy counter refusal as a coverage determination under Medicare part D.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Streamlining Part D

5 Appeals Process Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROVIDING FOR THE TREATMENT OF A PHARMACY**2 **COUNTER REFUSAL AS A COVERAGE DETER-
3 MINATION UNDER MEDICARE PART D.**4 Section 1860D–4(g) of the Social Security Act (42
5 U.S.C. 1395w–104(g)) is amended by adding at the end
6 the following new paragraph:7 **“(3) TREATMENT OF PHARMACY COUNTER RE-
8 FUSAL AS COVERAGE DETERMINATION.—For plan
9 years beginning on or after January 1, 2020, the re-
10 fusal by a pharmacy to fill a prescription for a cov-
11 ered part D drug under a prescription drug plan
12 shall be treated as a coverage determination subject
13 to reconsideration and appeal pursuant to this sub-
14 section and subsection (h).”.**
