A BILL

To amend the Indian Health Care Improvement Act to authorize urban Indian organizations to enter into arrangements for the sharing of medical services and facilities, and for other purposes.

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Health Care Access
3 for Urban Native Veterans Act of 2019”.

4 **SEC. 2. SHARING ARRANGEMENTS WITH FEDERAL AGEN-**
5 **CIES.**

6 Section 405 of the Indian Health Care Improvement
7 Act (25 U.S.C. 1645) is amended—

8 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by inserting “urban In-
9 dian organizations,” before “and tribal organiza-
10 tions”; and

11 (2) in subsection (c)—

12 (A) by inserting “urban Indian organiza-
13 tion,” before “or tribal organization”; and

14 (B) by inserting “an urban Indian organi-
15 zation,” before “or a tribal organization”.

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
