Mr. PERDUE (for himself and Mr. ISAKSON) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To redesignate the Jimmy Carter National Historic Site as the “Jimmy Carter National Historical Park”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Jimmy Carter National
5 Historical Park Redesignation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. JIMMY CARTER NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Jimmy Carter National His-
8 toric Site shall be known and designated as the “Jimmy
9 Carter National Historical Park”.

1 (b) AMENDMENTS TO PUBLIC LAW 100–206.—Pub-
2 lic Law 100–206 (54 U.S.C. 320101 note; 101 Stat.
3 1434) is amended—

4 (1) in section 1(a), in the matter preceding
5 paragraph (1), by striking “National Historic Site”
6 and inserting “National Historical Park”;

7 (2) in section 3—

8 (A) in subsection (a), by striking “provi-
9 sions of law generally applicable to national his-
10 toric sites” and inserting “provisions of law
11 generally applicable to units of the National
12 Park System”; and

13 (B) in subsection (d), in the second sen-
14 tence, by striking “National Historic Site” and
15 inserting “National Historical Park”;

16 (3) in section 6(2), by striking “National His-
17 toric Site” and inserting “National Historical
18 Park”;

19 (4) by striking “historic site” each place it ap-
20 pears and inserting “historical park”;

21 (5) by striking “**HISTORIC SITE**” each place it
22 appears and inserting “**HISTORICAL PARK**”; and

23 (6) by striking “HISTORIC SITE” each place it
24 appears and inserting “HISTORICAL PARK”.

1 (c) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law, regula-
2 tion, document, record, map, or other paper of the United
3 States to the Jimmy Carter National Historic Site shall
4 be considered to be a reference to the “Jimmy Carter Na-
5 tional Historical Park”.
