A BILL

To direct the Comptroller General of the United States to conduct a study to evaluate the failures and total system breakdown of the 2020 Iowa caucuses, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Determining Election
5 Blunders And Correcting Logical Errors Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. GAO STUDY ON THE FAILURES AND TOTAL SYSTEM**
2 **BREAKDOWN OF THE 2020 IOWA CAUCUSES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General
5 of the United States (in this section referred to as the
6 “Comptroller General”) shall initiate a study of—

7 (1) mismanagement by State party leaders
8 overseeing the 2020 Iowa caucuses;

9 (2) the degree to which top-down decision mak-
10 ing by the Democratic National Committee contrib-
11 uted to the failures of the 2020 Iowa caucuses;

12 (3) whether actions by State party leaders and
13 the Democratic National Committee contributed to
14 cyber vulnerabilities in the technology employed for
15 the 2020 Iowa caucuses;

16 (4) the extent to which the 2020 Iowa caucuses
17 have shaken the public’s faith and confidence in the
18 Iowa election system; and

19 (5) the potential dangers in changing election
20 technology and methods from existing approaches.

21 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 6 months after initi-
22 ating the study required by subsection (a), the Comp-
23 troller General shall submit to the Committee on Rules
24 and Administration of the Senate and the Committee on
25 House Administration of the House of Representatives a
26 report on the results of the study that sets forth the find-

1 ings, conclusions, and recommendations, if any, of the
2 study.
