Mr. CRAMER (for himself and Mr. SULLIVAN) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To require the removal of United States Armed Forces from
Saudi Arabia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Strained Partnership
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES**
7 **FROM SAUDI ARABIA.**

8 (a) REMOVAL.—All United States Armed Forces and
9 equipment, including Patriot missile batteries and the
10 Terminal High Altitude Area Defense (THAAD) system,
11 shall be removed from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia by

1 not later than 90 days after the date of the enactment
2 of this Act.

3 (b) RELOCATION OF EQUIPMENT.—Patriot missile
4 batteries and the Terminal High Altitude Area Defense
5 system relocated pursuant to subsection (a) shall, to the
6 extent practicable, be relocated to another location or loca-
7 tions in the Middle East, with the priority mission of pro-
8 tecting United States Armed Forces.

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
