A BILL

To extend the authority for the establishment by the Peace Corps Commemorative Foundation of a commemorative work to commemorate the mission of the Peace Corps and the ideals on which the Peace Corps was founded, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Peace Corps Com-
5 memorative Work Extension Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR ESTABLISHMENT**
2 **OF COMMEMORATIVE WORK TO COMMEMO-**
3 **RATE THE MISSION OF THE PEACE CORPS**
4 **AND THE IDEALS ON WHICH THE PEACE**
5 **CORPS WAS FOUNDED.**

6 Notwithstanding section 8903(e) of title 40, United
7 States Code, the authority to establish the commemorative
8 work under section 1(a) of Public Law 113–78 (40 U.S.C.
9 8903 note; 128 Stat. 647) shall continue to apply through
10 January 24, 2028.
