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## A BILL

To repeal the temporary exemption to the certification requirement under section 5323 of title 49, United States Code, for contracts between public transportation agencies and rolling stock manufacturers.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Secure Our Transit  
5       Systems from Chinese Interference Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON CERTAIN ROLLING STOCK PRO-**  
2 **CUREMENTS.**

3 Section 5323(u)(5) of title 49, United States Code,  
4 is amended—

5 (1) by striking “(A) PARTIES TO EXECUTED  
6 CONTRACTS.—”; and

7 (2) by striking subparagraphs (B) and (C).

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
