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## A BILL

To prohibit in-person instructional requirements during the  
COVID–19 emergency.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Don’t Punish Schools  
5       for Uncontrolled Pandemics Act of 2020”.

6       **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF IN-PERSON INSTRUCTIONAL RE-**  
7                       **QUIREMENTS DURING COVID–19 EMER-**  
8                       **GENCY.**

9       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no rule,  
10       regulation, guidance, or policy regarding an applicable

1 program (as defined in section 400 of the General Edu-  
2 cation Provisions Act (20 U.S.C. 1221)) shall require a  
3 local program to conduct in-person instruction during an  
4 emergency, as declared by a Federal, State, or local au-  
5 thority, with respect to COVID–19.
